The Street Festival takes place in early June (June 11 and 12 for 2010) at the corner of East Street and Stevens Street, here in Indianapolis, each year. So come and join us as we celebrate our Italian heritage.

Also, on the Saturday of the festival, there is an early afternoon mass at Holy Rosary Catholic Church.
